ORDER

Upon consideration of plaintiff’s Motion for Partial Judgment on the Pleadings, along with its Memorandum of Points and Authorities in support thereof, and upon consideration of the response thereto submitted by the defendant, it is by the Court, this ___ day of _____, 2012,

ORDERED, that the plaintiff’s motion be, and it is hereby, granted, and defendant is hereby enjoined from continuing to withhold non-exempt records responsive to plaintiff’s April 21, 2011 request, under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”); and it is further

ORDERED, that, within 30 days of the entry of this Order, defendant shall conduct and complete its search for all records responsive to plaintiff’s FOIA request, and shall produce and deliver to plaintiff all records responsive to plaintiff’s FOIA request that are not claimed to be exempt under FOIA, and shall produce and deliver to plaintiff a *Vaughn* Index of any responsive records withheld under a claim of exemption; and it is further

ORDERED, that, within 45 days after production of the *Vaughn* Index by defendant, the parties report to the Court with a proposed schedule for submission of dispositive motions

and a briefing schedule with respect thereto, regarding any FOIA exemption claims made by defendant that will require further litigation to resolve.
