AMENDED ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

CAME THIS DAY the Plaintiffs, by counsel, upon their Application for Temporary Injunction. Upon review of the pleadings and the arguments of counsel, and for good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Application for Temporary Injunction is GRANTED in part for the reasons set forth in the letter opinion attached hereto and incorporated herein, and upon the terms set forth in this Order.
2. The Department of State Police and all law enforcement divisions,

agencies, and officers within the Commonwealth, are hereby enjoined from enforcing Virginia Code § 18.2-308.2:5 in the context of handgun sales to adults under the age of 21;

3. This Temporary Injunction shall take effect immediately and remain in effect until October 15, 2020, or until such time as the Court may dissolve, modify, or extend this Temporary Injunction by further order.

4. No injunction bond shall be required pursuant to Virginia Code § 8.01-631.

5. The Court waives endorsement of counsel pursuant to Rule 1:13 of the Rules of Virginia Supreme Court.
